Brenda LaBier was born in New York and currently lives in Denver, Colorado. She received her BA in Art History from the State University of New York at Binghamton and a BFA in Photography from Metropolitan State University of Denver.

LaBier's many years of experience in the visual arts include art administration in museum and gallery organizations. In her professional endeavors she has curated over 100 exhibitions as Curator of the Contemporary Art Center of Virginia, and as Curatorial Administrator for the Frederick R. Weisman Art Foundation in Los Angeles where she organized exhibitions and conservation projects.

As an emerging artist she has shown internationally and nationally exhibiting frequently in Denver, Los Angeles, and Virginia. Her artworks move from realism to abstraction while maintaining her individuality and ability to portray her emotions through her conceptual contemporary photography, sculpture, and installation often expressing the themes of memory, trauma and identity.
